NEPA Inclusive believes people with disabilities should live where, with who, and in the way they want and that those who want to work can work in an area of their interest in a “typical” job in the community. Both work and living support services can and should be delivered to support you in the manner you choose. We offer a variety of consultative and customizable services designed to help you build a unique set of services so you can live the life you want.

LIVE *inclusive*

Where someone lives is a very personal choice. Our interest lies in helping support the person to live where and with who they want and with the supports they need to remain inclusive in their community.

We offer a variety of supported living services, such as **Companion Services , Home and Community Habilitation, and Respite**—all designed help the person achieve their goals and the social life they choose.

We also believe inclusive living requires long range planning so that transitioning from living with your family to a **Supported Living** arrangement takes time and planning. We want to be there every step of the way to ensure that the individual is always supported in the living arrangement of their choice. Supported Living can include living in your own home or apartment with or without a roommate or in **Family Living** environments.

Ask about our **Support Broker Services**

People with ID Waivers can Self-Direct their services in Pennsylvania. We offer **Support Brokers** who can help you do that. They help with HR functions such as hiring staff and knowing how to file payroll with the state, as well as training and staff files. Support Brokers also help with budgeting and locating services. They are your guide to help you along the way.

WORK *inclusive*

NEPA Inclusive can help you learn the skills you need to work in the job of your choice—starting at age 14 through graduating and ‘aging out’ of high school and into adulthood. We can also help you find a job in the community (competitive integrated and customizable - always for at least the minimum wage and for the same rate as anyone else performing the same job) that is right for you and then support you in that job as long as you need us.



Transition Inclusive—ages 14—graduation

Our **Transitional Employment** services include directly working with local high schools and as a Vendor with the Office Of Vocational Rehabilitation (**OVR**) to provide employment development services for high school students. As a **Pre-Employment Transitional Services (PETS)** Vendor with OVR, we provide **Job Shadowing, On-The-Job-Training, Community Based Work Assessments, and Work Based Learning Experiences**. All of these services are blended together as a strategy pointing towards the vocation of your choice upon graduation.

Work Inclusive—Adults

Our adult Job Development services include **Job Finding and Job Coaching** as a Vendor through the Office of Vocational Rehabilitation (OVR) and **Supported Employment** through the ID Waiver system.

Looking at employment as a whole, NEPA Inclusive can help you move seamlessly through high school to a job as an adult and through the OVR ‘90 day’ phase into your waiver for services (for ID Waiver recipients).

In some cases, we recommend an **Employment Profile** be performed to develop a baseline for employment and use this profile when beginning job development services.


